

FEBRUARY WRAPPED!

In February, ComedKares marked significant achievements. As students prepare for examinations, participation in the centres slightly decreased. Program ratings remained consistently high at 4.5/5, reflecting the quality of offerings. The Mangalore centre expanded its influence by launching the Social Connect Through Field Visit at Shri Madhwa Vadiraja Institute of Technology & Management in Udupi. The ComedKares portal introduced a contest feature for the upcoming Regional Innovation Challenge, with the first round ending on March 3rd. Outreach efforts resulted in partnerships with 6 institutions and progress in 2 MOUs. Additionally, 12 events were conducted, including TechTies at Kalaburagi. Outreach activities extended with 3 induction programs and an FDP. Notable achievements included progress on a dog prosthetics project at JP and a triumphant win at IIT Dharwad.

INTRODUCING CONTESTS FEATURE!



Comedkares Contests is a platform where students can participate in challenges. A variety of challenges will be available for students to choose from, each running for a set span of time. During this period, students must comprehend the problem statement, work on it, and submit their final ideas before the specified deadline. From the admin side, there are two roles: admin and evaluator. The admin is responsible for creating contests and establishing the rubric used for evaluating the ideas. The evaluator, on the other hand, assesses the ideas based on the rubric and ranks the submissions. It's important to note that the final decision rests with the admin, who has the authority to override the evaluations and rankings provided by the evaluator.

SGBIT, BELAGAVI HOSTS FIRESIDE CHAT ON CYBERSECURITY



A fireside chat titled "Why Everyone Should Do Cyber" was held at SGBIT, Belagavi on the 12th of February. Swapneel Patnekar, CEO of Shreshta, a cyber security company, led the discussion with 72 students in attendance. The session focused on the importance of cybersecurity in the digital age, covering topics like common threats such as malware, phishing, and ransomware, along with practical steps to improve online safety.

The importance of cybersecurity in protecting personal data and resources for further learning were also addressed. This event aimed to empower students to be more secure in the online world.



FDP ON HAND TOOLS AND POWER TOOLS

The National Institute of Engineering, Mysore, in collaboration with Mysore ComedKares, organized a Faculty Development Program on Hand Tools and Power Tools. 

